#### **ARTICLE A - Fire Department**

##### **Section 11.1 Adoption of the Fire Prevention Code**

There is hereby adopted by the Town of Brusly, for the purpose of prescribing regulations governing conditions hazardous to life and property, from fire and explosion, that certain code known as the NFPA 1 Fire Prevention Code recommended by the National Fire Protection Association, being particularly the 2000 edition, save and except such portions as are deleted, modified, or amended, of which code not less than three copies have been filed in the offices of the clerk of the Town of Brusly and these copies are hereby adopted and incorporated as fully if set out at length in this article, and the provisions thereof shall be controlling within the limits of the Town of Brusly. Further, any amendments or additions to the State Uniform Fire Prevention Code, pursuant to LSA 40:1578.7(E) to conform to NFPA 1, as it is subsequently amended or issued as a new edition by the National Fire Protection Association shall hereby be adopted.

There is hereby further adopted by the Town of Brusly, for the purpose of prescribing regulations governing conditions hazardous to life and property, from fire and explosion, and for life safety that certain code known as the NFPA 101 Life Safety Code recommended by the National Fire Protection Association, being particularly the 2000 edition, save and except such portions as are deleted, modified, or amended, of which code not less than three copies have been filed in the offices of the clerk of the Town of Brusly and these copies are hereby adopted and incorporated as fully if set out at length in this article, and the provisions thereof shall be controlling within the limits of the Town of Brusly. Further, any amendments or additions to the State Uniform Fire Prevention Code, pursuant to LSA 40:1578.7(E) to conform to NFPA 101, as it is subsequently amended or issued as a new edition

by the National Fire Protection Association shall hereby be adopted.

**ARTICLE B - Trash Burning**

**Section 11.21 Trash fires.**

It shall be unlawful for any person to start or set any trash fire or to burn paper, grass, trash or debris, where such fire is not protected by a proper furnace or incinerator, within the Town of Brusly limits, unless such person has been issued a valid fire permit from the West Baton Rouge Fire District No.1, which includes the Town of Brusly within its area of responsibility.
